

Grange Community College Modern Foreign Language Exemption Procedure

In order to qualify for an exemption from a modern foreign language the pupil must meet the following criteria:

- Meet criteria for exemption from Irish and have exemption granted.
- Current literacy scores must be below the 10th percentile in word reading, spelling and/or sentence comprehension.
- Written request for exemption by parents/guardian

The pupil and parents will be made aware of the implications of this exemption with regard to Third level options.

A decision to grant the exemption will be arrived at by a designated panel of teaching staff which may include the Principal, Special Education Needs Co-ordinator, Year Head, Career Guidance Teacher and Language Subject Teacher.

A decision to grant an exemption may also follow consultation with the DDLETB Psychological Services Psychologist.
