Grange Community College Guidelines for November Assessments 2023

Parents/Guardians and students are asked to familiarise themselves with the following guidelines for the upcoming exams (20th- 24th November);

- 1. Students must present themselves for exams <u>5 minutes</u> before exams are due to start.
- 2. Students must sit at their assigned seat for every exam.
- 3. Students must be in **<u>full school uniform</u>** for every exam.
- 4. Students must remain in the exam hall until the exam is over.
- 5. Students must have pens, calculators and all equipment needed for exams.
- 6. Students who arrive late for an exam may have to remain in the exam hall until their full exam is over.
- 7. Any student who misses an exam may have to re-sit the exam at a later date.
- 8. Students must ask permission of the supervising teacher to use the toilets.
- 9. Students may bring a book or study notes to prepare for their next exam.
- 10. Talking is **<u>NOT</u>** permitted in the exam hall once the exam has started.
- 11.Food, drink, chewing gum and mobile phones are <u>NOT</u> permitted in the exam hall.
- 12.Students must go home for lunch following morning exams and should only return in the afternoon if they have an exam.
- 13.Students should remain at home when they have no scheduled exams.
